## **GOLDEN OAK RANCH RULES**

- 1. The speed limit on the Ranch is **15 M.P.H.**
- 2. Water trucks must arrive 30 minutes prior to equipment and crew landing to wet down the Ranch roads for dust control.
- 3. A location manager or person of equal or higher expertise must be present on property the entire time their crew is on site. The location department is expected to have a location person present on property from the arrival of the first crew member and until the departure of the last crew member.
- 4. The Ranch normal operating hours, excluding live shoot days are 6 AM to 6 PM, Monday thru Friday. The Ranch is closed on weekends unless prior arrangements are made with Ranch management. A Security Guard must be provided by the production company to control access to the Ranch during times outside the Ranch's normal hours of operation, including weekends.
- Security Officers used in conjunction with production in any manner must follow the California State Standards and possess required documentation on their person and display it when requested. Crew members may not be used as Security Officers.
- 6. One additional security officer is required for every 25 extras.
- 7. No friends or family are allowed on the Ranch. There are no exceptions to this rule unless granted by Ranch management in advance. Children are not allowed on the premises unless the child is a cast member with a work permit and accompanied by a welfare worker/teacher. Children under the age of eighteen (18) must be always accompanied by an adult.
- 8. No personal pets are permitted on the property. Service dogs are permitted; advanced notice is preferred. A service dog is defined as a dog that is specifically trained to perform a function, such as a Seeing Eye dog. Comfort animals are not considered service dogs.
- 9. The Ranch is large, and it is easy for crew member to become lost. Each crew is required to post directional signs at interval sufficient to allow crew members to easily find their parking location or set.
- 10. All crew and/or personal vehicles must be parked in the "Crew Parking" area only unless prior arrangements have been made with the Ranch staff.
- 11. The Golden Oak Ranch is in a wilderness area and portions lie within a National Forest. As a wilderness area, the terrain of the Ranch includes holes, rocks, hills, challenging slopes and terrain, and hazardous vegetation, such as poison oak and sumac. In addition, wildlife such as rattlesnakes, bobcats, and mountain lions frequent this region. Entry is at your own risk. All minors must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- 12. All persons associated with production are to stay in the area contracted by the production company. Hiking, touring, foot traffic or sightseeing are prohibited. Production is responsible for providing shuttle vehicles for the crew.
- 13. No motorized vehicles are allowed on the grass unless approved by management as part of filming.
- 14. The use of bicycles, razors, scooters, or similar conveyances, motorized or not, are not permitted for use on Ranch property.
- 15. Smoking is restricted based upon weather conditions. Smoking is to occur in designated area and never in grass or brush areas.

- 16. Possession or consumption of alcohol and/or drugs is prohibited on Ranch property.
- 17. Possession or usage of live ammunition on Ranch property is forbidden.
- 18. All trash generated by production companies must be cleared away and lawfully removed from Ranch premises. The Ranch trash dumpsters are for Ranch use only.
- 19. Sets are not governed by building codes and may not be suitable for all uses. Licensee is responsible for insuring sets are suitable for the intended use.
- 20. Sets must be restored to the condition they were contracted in. This includes, but is not limited to patching holes, painting, construction, and cleaning. Drilling, nailing, stapling, and screwing to the sets requires Ranch approval and it must be restored. A final walkthrough with Locations and a Ranch Site Rep is required. Final walkthroughs are not conducted at night/ in the dark unless a crew is booked for the following day. Locations must be prepared to return the following morning.
- 21. The use of tumbleweeds, cattail, Oleanders, Pennisetum Grass, Bermuda grass or lily pads is not allowed on the Ranch premises without prior approval from Ranch management.
- 22. No chemicals of any kind may be added to the lakes or creeks. Any chemicals added to ranch foliage, must be approved in advance by the Ranch Manager.
- 23. The Oak trees are protected by state law and the ground beneath them is limited to foot traffic only. Nailing to or trimming of <u>any</u> tree is prohibited. Tying anything to the trees must be approved in advance by Ranch Management.
- 24. Use of Ranch water must be approved by Ranch Management. Ranch water is not considered potable.
- 26. Repair cost for damages to grass and/ or fields is at \$5,800.00/ acre or a portion thereof.
- 27. Crew Parking and Base Camp are assigned for shoot days only. Loading in or loading out on any other day requires a 48-hour notice and Ranch Approval.
- 28. Locations, a Security Guard, and a water truck are required for loading in and loading out. There is a \$1,000.00 per hour fee for loading in or loading out outside of the scheduled production hours.
